Sarova Stanley Hotel, Nairobi.

Old world charm and historic features make the landmark Sarova Stanley unique. Situated amidst the bustling shops and restaurants of Nairobi, the hotel has hosted some of the world's most famous VIPs during their visits to Kenya. Amenities: Restaurants, bar, pool deck, ultra-modern health and fitness club with heated swimming pool, wireless Internet access.

Samburu Sopa Lodge, Samburu.

Samburu Sopa Lodge is built overlooking the wildlife-rich banks of the Ewaso Nyiro River within the ancestral lands of the Samburu, who are close relatives of the Masai. The public areas are airy and spacious with views of the surrounding area. There is a swimming pool with relaxing loungers, much needed after a day on safari. Facilities include: Bar, Gift shop, Laundry, Swimming pool, evening turn down service, guided nature walks, bird watching, and Samburu cultural talks.

Mt. Kenya Safari Club.

The Mount Kenya Safari Club is situated on the foothills of Mt. Kenya, bordering the Mt. Kenya National Park. Built in 1938, the Club was originally the retreat of famous movie star William Holden. Amenities: Restaurant, bar/lounge, airstrip, heated swimming pool, beauty salon, sauna, 9-hole golf course, tennis, croquet, bird walks, bush banquets, horse riding, trout fishing, bowling, croquet.

Sarova Lion Hill Game Lodge

Situated in the Rift Valley of Kenya, among the various Nakuru lodges and set on a plateau in an elevation above Lake Nakuru, Sarova Lion Hill Game Lodge has 67 chalets all overlooking the lake, within the Lake Nakuru National Park in Nakuru town. It is the perfect place to experience one of the world's largest ornithological spectacles, the Pink Flamingo, or a rich concentration of wildlife including black and white Colobus monkey and is also a famed Rhino Sanctuary.

Mara Sopa Lodge

Located on the slopes of Oloongams Hills, it is one of the first lodges to be built in the Masai Mara Game Reserve. Guests are drawn to this lodge built in an ethnic design, surrounded by a rich landscape, covered in fauna, from huge desert cacti to sweet smelling jasmine flowers, all within the fabled Masai Mara Game Reserve.

Treetops Hotel, Aberdare

Nestled deep in the forests of Aberdare National Park, this world-renowned rustic tree house is dedicated to game viewing. Originally built in 1932, Treetops is famous as the place where the then-Princess Elizabeth learned of her father's death and ascended to the British Throne in 1952. There are 48 cozy rooms and two suites, a lounge overlooking the waterhole and two bars. There is also a restaurant where dinner is served on charming old world refectory tables with bench seating. It is 17 km away from Outspan Hotel, where guests begin and end their journey to Treetops. Guests are advised to bring warm clothing as nights can get chilly at this lodge, which is 6,450m above sea level.

The Ark, Aberdare

Set in the heart of the Aberdare National Park, The Ark is an unique tree lodge with a veranda that overlooks a floodlit waterhole and saltlick allowing undisturbed views of wildlife visiting the waterhole. Elephant, rhino, leopard, bushbuck and occasionally an elusive bongo and giant forest hog have been sighted. The 60 guest rooms are all en-suite. All cabins have private bathrooms with shower, and are comfortably furnished with bedside lamps and carpeted floors to ward off the evening and morning chill. Close to your room are views of the forest or waterhole, revealing game.

Itinerary

Day 1 - Depart home for Africa.

Day 2 - Nairobi, Kenya: Connect through an international gateway and arrive in Nairobi. After clearing customs and immigration, meet your local ABC Destinations tour director and transfer to your hotel. Nairobi is a cosmopolitan and lively city, the largest between Johannesburg and Cairo.

Day 3 - Nairobi/Samburu: After breakfast, journey north passing near Thika, which boasts the world's third largest pineapple plantation, and Karatina with its colorful market. Head further north, crossing the Equator to an outpost known as Isiolo. From here, it's a fairly short ride to your lodge, located on the banks of the Ewaso Nyiro River, in the heart of the Shaba National Reserve, famous for the "Out of Africa" film. It has now been made famous once again with the shooting of the third edition of the television phenomenon "Survivor" on this location. Arrive for lunch at the lodge and enjoy an afternoon game drive in the reserve. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 4 - Samburu/Mt Kenya: Enjoy a full day of exploring the Shaba and Buffalo Springs National Reserves. The Shaba Reserve is named after an outcrop of volcanic rock that dominates the region. Evidence of the intensity of its upheaval is demonstrated by the formidable lava flow that travelers must cross to reach the reserve and the lodge. The Reserve's northern boundary is marked by the width of the Ewaso Nyiro River, which empties into the Lorian Swamp. The tall doum palms mark its course in silent contrast to the rugged and pitted tracts, which make up much of the sanctuary. Many small hills dot the landscape and, with four springs, Shaba is better watered than its neighbors. Animals commonly seen are elephants, lions, cheetahs, Grevy's Zebras, giraffes, Gerenuks, buffalo, oryx, Grants Gazelles, Dikdiks and waterbuck. The river forest also attracts a wide variety of birds. Breakfast, lunch and dinner at the lodge. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 5 - Mt Kenya: After breakfast, depart for the exclusive Mt Kenya Safari Club. Mt Kenya is Africa's second highest massif, and its twin peaks top one of the world's highest national parks. As you travel around to the other side of the mountain, you'll come to the town of Nanyuki, nestled into the lush slopes of this mountain astride the Equator. It is here where you come to rest in time for a buffet lunch at the incomparable Mount Kenya Safari Club, the playground to the rich and famous for years, and understandably so, with its lush, landscaped gardens, golf course, swimming pool, and, of course, breathtaking views of the snow capped mountain. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 6 - Mt Kenya/Aberdare: After breakfast depart for Aberdare Country Club, the base hotel for The Ark. After lunch at the club, drive to The Ark, a uniquely shaped lodge tucked away in the Aberdares National Park forest. The lodge's water hole and salt lick are well lit at night when the animals come to drink, and a well-concealed "hide" affords eye to eye viewing of forest elephant and other game, including the endangered Black rhino. Look out for baboon, buffalo, bushbuck, bush pig, civets, duikers, giant forest hog, Colobus and Syke's monkeys. The birdlife includes some species not common in other places among them being: green ibis, rufus sparrow hawk, mountain buzzard, crowned eagle and the silvery-cheeked hornbill. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 7 - Aberdare/Lake Nakuru: After breakfast at the Ark, return to the base hotel where you will proceed to Lake Nakuru with a brief stop at Nyahururu to view Thompson's Falls and its 237-foot cascade. Then travel south to Lake Nakuru, colored a shimmering flamingo pink from thousands of the beautiful birds lining its shores. You'll arrive at Lion Hill Lodge - affording unforgettable views of the lake from its hillside perch. The lodge is also a perfect base from which to explore the lake, with its fabulous array of birds as well as many types of game, including waterbuck, rhino, leopard and buffalo. Buffet lunch at the lodge. Afternoon game drive in the park, which is, of course, known for its birdlife - as thousands of Flamingos make this their home, among hundreds of other species. But wildlife is also in abundance here. You'll see large numbers of waterbuck, warthog, impala, buffalo, plains game, cheetah, and now rhino, as Lake Nakuru National Park now hosts one of Kenya's rhino sanctuaries. Your lodge is an oasis of comfort and excellent service with its commanding views of the surroundings and the animals, which graze peacefully, close by. The Acacia and Euphorbia forests are havens for animals during the heat of the day, making an excellent game-viewing destination, whilst the "Hippo Pool" is a favorite spot for picnics. The park is known for its birdlife, as thousands of flamingos make this lake their home, among hundreds of other species. But wildlife is also in abundance here: you'll also see large numbers of waterbuck, warthog, impala, buffalo, plains game and cheetah. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 8 - Lake Nakuru/Maasai Mara: After breakfast at the lodge, leave the flamingo-fringed Lake Nakuru behind, and drive to Narok, gateway to the Maasai Mara and district headquarters of this part of Maasailand. This afternoon you will start your first game viewing drive in the reserve, regarded as the most magnificent natural theatre in the world. Set in the heart of Africa's Great Plains, the Maasai Mara boasts 1,672 sq kms of unspoiled wilderness and is home to the highest concentration of animals and birds anywhere on the continent. The Maasai Mara Game Reserve is the natural habitat for lions, elephants, leopards, cheetahs, hippo, rhino, buffalo, zebra, giraffe, wildebeest, and much other game. Sarova Mara Camp is set in the African bush but the luxurious tents all have permanent roofs, zip-up fronts, and electricity and en-suite facilities. Relaxing outside your own tent listening to the orchestra of rasping cicadas, croaking tree frogs and the intermittent call of birds and monkeys is a memorable symphony. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 9 - Maasai Mara: Enjoy a full day in the Maasai Mara with two game drives included. After breakfast this morning you will be taken on a complimentary visit to a Maasai Village. The Maasai Mara National Park is situated to the west of Nairobi, on Tanzania's northern border and is the extension to the larger Serengeti National Park in Tanzania. The Maasai Mara offers wonderful scenery and an abundance of big game. It is perhaps the only region left in Kenya where the visitor may see animals in the same super-abundance as existed a century ago. It is a reserve of breathtaking vistas, panoramas of vast rolling plains, hills and woodland groves, well watered by the lovely Mara River, which bisects the reserve from north to south. The Mara is home to the largest population of lions in Kenya. These magnificent beasts spend most of the day sleeping in the shade of acacia trees. Vast herds of buffalo, zebra and wildebeest roam the plains. Impala, gazelle, giraffe and hartebeest grace the landscape, and the cautious topi may also be seen standing sentinel on earth mounds on constant lookout of predators. The waters of the Mara River are home to crocodiles and pools of hippo, the acacia woodlands and riverine forests favored by leopard and elephant, and the open savannah and dry bush areas play host to the plains game and their attendant predators such as lion, cheetah, hyena and jackal. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 10 - Maasai Mara/Nairobi: After an early breakfast, bid farewell to the Mara as you set off on your journey back to Nairobi (approximately 5 ½ hour drive). Transfer to the hotel where a day room has been arranged for you. Enjoy a lunch at the Carnivore restaurant followed by a visit to the Giraffe Center and a Nairobi dusk city tour. Later you will be transferred to Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in time for your scheduled flight back to the USA. (Breakfast)

Day 11 - Arrive home with a lifetime of memories!
